**Montréal, October 6, 2020** — Daniel Coderre, President and CEO of Génome Québec, is happy to announce the appointment of Stéphanie Lord-Fontaine, PhD as Vice President, Scientific Affairs. The decision was unanimously endorsed by the Board of Directors on September 23, 2020. Ms. Lord-Fontaine will be taking up her duties on October 19, 2020.

Ms. Lord-Fontaine has held a wide range of leadership positions in research administration at both the provincial and federal levels, where she acquired extensive experience in the life sciences, research and innovation sectors. She had in-depth knowledge of all areas of genomics. From 2007 to 2017, she worked for Génome Québec as Senior Director in the Scientific Affairs team. Ms. Lord-Fontaine understands and subscribes to the organization's corporate culture and is well versed in the issues affecting the genomics ecosystem in Québec, in Canada and around the world, whether in health, agrifood, forestry or the environment.

Since 2017, she has acquired valuable strategic leadership and partnership building skills. Her accomplishments earned Oncople a nomination as a finalist for ADRIQ's Prix Innovation — Sciences de la vie in 2018.

In a context where genomics is in full growth and the future of this disruptive technology relies on our capacity to make the most of this progress and its alignment with artificial intelligence, Daniel Coderre says that "the timing of Stéphanie's return is just perfect. In addition to her expert knowledge of genomics and its related opportunities, she comes to us with a rich track record in terms of her network in Québec, in Canada and around the world, combined with a clear vision on the strategic positioning of genomics within the ecosystem. We are pleased to welcome this long-time ally aboard, given her commitment to the success of Génome Québec and Québec researchers in the field."
